<b>Detailed Description of "Goods/Services Delivery Requirement" and/or scope of work.</b>	
<p>This RFQ is to <b>supply, install, manage and dismantle devices for traffic control services at various locations.</b></p> <p>The services will be provided to facilitate Brun-Way's asphalt hand patching operations. The ability to set up and dismantle two (2) lane closures sequentially back to back will be required.</p> <p>The Contractor will supply, install, manage and dismantle all of the traffic control devices required as per the 2009 WATCM (revised January 31, 2020).</p> <p>Any violations to this manual can result in Brun-Way receiving a \$30,000 penalty from our Client. This penalty if received will be forwarded to and be the responsibility of successful Contractor.</p> <p>The contractor will be required to provide traffic control according to layouts 8-7 and 8-7 VS &amp; 7-5 on intersecting roadways. The anticipated work duration will be less than 3 days at each location, with a maximum activity area of 4km.</p> <p>Some Work locations will involve ramps so additional signage and traffic control people could be required in these locations which the Contractor is responsible to provide.</p> <p>Brun-Way will perform their own traffic control audits to ensure compliance with WATCM. This does not relieve the Contractor of their responsibilities.</p> <p>The work is expected to begin once weather permits around May 11 and continue for approximately 20 weeks as required.</p> <p>The work will be located along Rte 2 and Rte 95 at various locations between Longs Creek and the Quebec Border including a number of ramps and intersecting roads. The Contractors Traffic Control Agent will coordinate the locations with the Brun-Way representative.</p> <p>Crews will be working anywhere from 0 - 16 hours per day.</p> <p>No work is expected on weekends, holidays, or rain days but may be required depending on the schedule.</p> <p>Bids should include an hourly rate which includes all labour, equipment, materials, mobilization/demobilization, meals, hotels, etc, for work up to 12 hours in a day. **Summary of Specific Safety Requirements**

- Employees who will be onsite will be required to receive Brun-Way's Safety Orientation from a Brun-Way representative before work can begin. The orientation will take approximately 4 hours to complete. It will be the responsibility of the Contractor to ensure that all employees receive this training from Brun-Way representative
- Minimum PPE requirements are CSA Hard Hat, high viz safety vest, CSA approved steel toe boots (min 6" height), Long sleeve shirts for all personnel onsite, and safety glasses. Gloves shall be carried at all times; no manual handling may take place without use of gloves. Hearing protection shall be carried, and used as required.
- All knives shall be self retracting
- Any lifting over 15 kg per individual requires a risk assessment be complete and no individual shall lift greater than 20 kg.
- Stretching is recommended at the start of each workday.
- The successful bidder must;
  - Complete a Job Hazard Analysis for all activities using the SNC-Lavalin form and methodology prior to starting any work; and
  - Use the Stepback Risk Evaluation method while completing the project.

The successful bidder shall adhere to all requirements outlined in the Health and Safety program, including all post award document submissions

As per Section 6.2 of the Contractor Management SOP the classification level of this contract is Level 3.
